

### How they Voted?

First Council vote on AURA permit June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Note: 5 – 3 simple majority requires a second vote on June 28th

<b>Mayor/Council Member</b>	<b>How they voted</b>	<b>Stated reason</b>
Mayor Pam Hemminger	No	Likes that Aura in on BRT, but conflicted about pedestrian safety.
Jess Andersen	Yes	Supports density because of BRT. Concerned about stormwater impacts and vegetative buffer conditions.
Allen Buansi	No	Concerned about unaddressed questions about stormwater, traffic and safety.
Hongbin Gu	No	Concerned about traffic, stormwater runoff volumes and pedestrian safety.
Tai Huynh	Yes	Supports density, not concerned about traffic. Cites unprecedented amount of traffic and stormwater study
Michael Parker	Yes	Support because of climate change and need for density. Satisfied with depth of analysis on stormwater and traffic issues.
Amy Ryan	Yes	Staff response satisfied early concern about buffers and trees. Supports density believing it to be appropriate place for it.
Karen Stegman	Yes	Initially concerned about 650 parking spaces, now convinced Aura is transit oriented walkable, and climate change friendly. Does not believe traffic will be a problem.
